Frequently Asked Questions

The following is a list of questions students often have regarding the training program they are registered to attend.

Where will my course be held? Your course will be held in the Education Center of the *EmergencyCare* facility located at 1926 Peach street Erie, PA 16502.

Where should I Park? Free off-street parking is available to individuals attending a course at *EmergencyCare* in Lot # 1, and Lot # 3 of our facility. There is also free on-street parking available on 20th street which is located on the South side of our complex.

What entrance should I use? When you arrive at our facility please enter our building using the **EmergencyCare Education Center entrance** located on the 20th street side of our complex.

How long will my course take? The length of the course you are attending depends on the type of course it is. For example, a standard CPR course takes 3 to 4 hours to complete, while a standard First Aid course that includes CPR takes 4 to 5 hours to complete.
