

EmergyCare: EMS Education Specialist

Position: Full-time Non-Exempt

The EMS Education Specialist will provide local level course coordination and primary instruction to deliver content, skills instruction and remediation for EmergyCare. This includes but is not limited to initial EMS provider certification programs, annual skills competency reviews, subject matter specific continuing education programs and coordinating clinical field rotations for students participating in programs managed through Education. The EMS Education Specialist will also actively participate in the planning, implementation, and evaluation of programs and related projects.

This position will act as a back up to the Education and Training Manager and will provide administrative support for the educational programming; position operates as a shared resource between Education and Operations and will have regularly scheduled EMT rotational shifts in Operations.

Required Qualifications:

- A minimum of an Associate Degree from an accredited academic institution.
- At least two years of EMS field experience, part of which should be in EMS education.
- A current certification from the PADOHBEMS as an EMT or higher.
- Be certified as a PADOHBEMS EMS Instructor.
- Possess (within 90 days of hire) instructional certification in American Heart Association Basic Life Support CPR, Advanced Cardiac Life Support, Pediatric Life Support and maintain required certifications going forward.
- Possess (within 90 days of hire) the instructional certification from VFIS Emergency Vehicle Drivers training.
- Demonstrated ability to: evaluate, design and implement curriculum, testing and/or teaching methodologies; work both independently and in a team environment; effectively/efficiently manage multiple tasks
- Must have excellent organizational and project management skills; excellent student management skills along and verbal and written communication skills
- Must hold a valid Driver's License.

Preferred qualifications include:

- Bachelor's Degree or higher from an accredited academic institution.
- Current certification from the PA DOHBEMS as a Paramedic or higher or be willing to obtain the certification within the first 18 months of hire
- Hold instructor status in International Trauma Life Support
- Have working knowledge of Microsoft Office application to include Word, Excel, Access, PowerPoint, etc.
