EmergencyCare is hiring a Full-Time EMS Education Specialist

The EMS Education Specialist will provide local level course coordination and primary instruction to deliver content, skills instruction and remediation for EmergencyCare and EmergencyCare-UPMC-CEM Paramedic Training Consortium education offerings. This requirement includes but is not limited to initial EMS provider certification programs, annual skills competency reviews, subject matter specific continuing education programs. The EMS Education Specialist will also actively participate in the planning, implementation, and evaluation of programs and related projects.

This position is a "hands-on" position with responsibilities in direct instruction, performing all administrative duties in support of the Education Department as well as direct clinical work as a Paramedic when business needs dictate. In addition, this position will act as a back up to the Paramedic Program director.

First year of employment, incumbent will work solely in the Education Department. Second year going forward, this position may operate as a shared resource between Education and Operations based on business needs.

Qualification Requirements:

- A minimum of an Associate Degree from an accredited academic institution and at least two years of EMS field experience, part of which should be in EMS education.
- A current certification from the PADOHBEMS as a Paramedic or higher.
- Be certified as a PADOHBEMS EMS Instructor.
- Possess (within 90 days of hire) instructional certification in American Heart Association Basic Life Support CPR, Advanced Cardiac Life Support, Pediatric Life Support and maintain required certifications going forward.
- Must have excellent organizational and student management skills, verbal and written communication skills; demonstrated ability to evaluate, design and implement curriculum, testing and/or teaching methodologies.
- Must have valid Driver's License: position requires ability to travel as needed
- Must be willing and able to function as a front-line Paramedic as business needs dictate.

Preferred qualifications include:

- Bachelor's Degree or higher from an accredited academic institution.
- Completed a PADOHBEMS approved Critical Care Transport Program.
- Hold instructor status in International Trauma Life Support
- Be a Nationally Registered Paramedic.
- Possess working knowledge of Microsoft Office application to include Word, Excel, Access, PowerPoint, etc.
