Required Qualifications:

- A minimum of an Associate Degree from an accredited academic institution
- At least three years of EMS field experience, part of which should be in EMS education.
- A current certification from the PADOHBEMS as a Paramedic or higher
- Must be certified as a PADOHBEMS EMS Instructor
- Possess (within 90 days of hire) instructional certification in American Heart Association Basic Life Support CPR, Advanced Cardiac Life Support, Pediatric Life Support and maintain required certifications going forward
- Valid Driver's License
- Must be able to periodically travel to EmergyCare facilities
- Must have excellent organization and management skills
- Must have the ability to evaluate, design and implement curriculum, testing and teaching methodologies
- Must work well independently and in a team environment

Preferred qualifications:

- Bachelor's Degree or higher from an accredited academic institution
- Completed a PADOHBEMS approved Critical Care Transport Program
- Nationally Registered Paramedic
- Working knowledge of Microsoft Office applications Word, Excel, Access, PowerPoint
