The Internal Education Coordinator provides coordination, management, and, when necessary, primary and/or secondary instruction of internal education and training needs required to support the mission of EmergencyCare. The Internal Education Coordinator will also coordinate clinical and field rotations for students participating in programs managed through education, such as EMT and Paramedic Certification courses as well as, but not limited to annual internal training days and skills competency reviews, and subject matter for specific continuing education programs. The Internal Education Coordinator will also actively participate in the planning, implementing, and evaluating of internal programs and related projects.

Required Qualifications

- A minimum of a bachelor's degree from an accredited academic institution.
- At least two years of EMS field experience, part of which should be in EMS education.
- A current certification from the PADOHBEMS as an EMT or higher.
- Be certified as a PADOHBEMS EMS Instructor.
- Possess (within 90 days of hire) instructional certification in American Heart Association Basic Life Support CPR, Advanced Cardiac Life Support, Pediatric Life Support, and maintain required certifications in the future.
- Possess (within 120 days of hire) instructional certification from VFIS in Emergency Vehicle Drivers Training.
- Demonstrated excellent organizational and student management skills.
- Demonstrated excellent verbal and written communication skills.
- Demonstrated ability to evaluate, design, and implement curriculum, testing, and/or teaching methodologies.
- Demonstrated ability to work both independently and in a team environment.
- Demonstrated ability to manage multiple tasks and/or projects effectively/efficiently.
- Have demonstrated excellent organizational and project management skills.
- Hold a valid Driver's License.

Preferred qualifications include:

- Bachelor's Degree or higher from an accredited academic institution.
- Current certification from the PA DOHBEMS as a Paramedic or higher or be willing to obtain certification within the first 18 months of hire.
- Hold instructor status in International Trauma Life Support
- Have working knowledge of Microsoft Office applications to include Word, Excel, Access, PowerPoint, etc.
