EmergyCare is hiring a full and part-time hourly non-exempt Wheelchair Transporter(s). This position provides transportation for wheelchair, medical taxi and stretcher transports taking patients to or from hospitals, nursing homes, doctor offices, and/or any other facility previously approved.

The Wheelchair Transporter works closely with the EMT in providing effective and efficient patient care in accordance with established protocols. The incumbent is accountable for the quality of emergency and non-emergency medical care delivered.

The WCT transporter performs all techniques of basic life support, provides specified field treatment for medical emergencies, and transports patients to the appropriate medical facility by way of ambulance, wheelchair and/or medical van.

The Wheelchair Transporter is required to obtain his/her Emergency Medical Responder (EMR) Certification within two (2) years of hire and maintain it going forward.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Qualified candidates must be a high school graduate or equivalent.
- Must have valid driver's license and excellent driving record.
- Successful applicant(s) must obtain Emergency Medical Responder (EMR) certification within two years of date of hire and maintain current EMR certification thereafter.
- Candidates **must be at least 21 years of age or older** due to regulations set forth by the PA Public Utilities Commission (PUC).
- Participation in the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) Vaccination program under the Federal Government Mandate is a requirement.

Preferred Qualifications:

Certification as a First Responder by the Commonwealth of PA, American Red Cross or the American Heart Association and a valid CPR card are preferred.

Qualified applicants will receive consideration for employment without regard to race, color, religion, sex, national origin, sexual orientation, gender identity, disability or protected veteran status.
