EmergencyCare Is Hiring: Full-time Operations Supervisor to manage the Greenville PA location.

Position provides direct supervision of the overall operations for EmergencyCare's Green, PA location.

The successful candidate will provide direct supervision of the daily operations of all ground-based EMS activities related to operations, including emergency and non-emergency ambulance services, advanced life support services, and paratransit/wheelchair services. The supervisor applies operational policies uniformly and consistently and is responsible for assuring the immediate/future operational capabilities of all units at all times. The supervisor is responsible for participation in interviews, hiring, training employees, planning, assigning and directing work, conducting performance appraisals, providing positive reinforcement to staff as well as issuing corrective action as appropriate. Must also manage staff availability to workload and ensure all vehicles and equipment are maintained to required standards.

The successful candidate must have demonstrated ability to work well with all levels of the organization and be a positive resource for staff and direct reports.

Minimum Requirements

- Current Certification as a Paramedic by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania with ITLS and ACLS certification.
- A minimum of four years of previous field experience as a Paramedic under medical command.
- Certificate from college or certified organization in supervisory training; or one-year related experience and/or training; or equivalent combination of education and experience.
- Must possess a current driver's license, CPR, ACLS and ITLS certifications.
- Must have strong computer skills including experience in all MS Office Products
- Position requires the physical ability to run calls and to work and function as a Paramedic as needed.
- Must pass a post-offer drug test and MVR and Criminal background checks
- Participation in the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) Vaccination program.

Preferred Qualifications:

- Four years of supervisory experience is preferred.
