EmergencyCare's mission is to save lives and positively impact health, well-being and safety in the communities we serve.

EmergencyCare is hiring full-time and part-time hourly non-exempt Wheelchair Transporters. This position provides transportation for wheelchair, medical taxi and stretcher transport patients, to hospitals, nursing homes, doctor offices, or any other facility previously approved. The wheelchair transporter works closely with the EMT in providing effective and efficient patient care in accordance with established protocols relevant to EMR certification.

Incumbent must obtain Emergency Medical Responder (EMR) certification within two years of date of hire and maintain current EMR certification thereafter. The Wheelchair Transporter (Emergency Medical Responder (EMR)) is fully responsible for all actions as a certified EMR and is accountable for the quality of emergency and non-emergency medical care delivered. In delivering pre-hospital emergency care, the EMR performs all techniques of basic life support, provides specified field treatment for medical emergencies, and transports patients to the appropriate medical facility. This includes ambulance, wheelchair and medical van.

To fulfill the requirements for this position, qualified candidates must be a high school graduate or equivalent and hold a valid driver's license. Due to regulations set forth by the PA Public Utilities Commission (PUC), candidates *must be at least 21 years of age or older.*

Certification as a First Responder by the Commonwealth of PA, American Red Cross or the American Heart Association and a valid CPR card are preferred.

Qualified applicants will receive consideration for employment without regard to race, color, religion, sex, national origin, sexual orientation, gender identity, disability or protected veteran status.
